Open to the public, this year's show returns to the South Point Hotel and Casino in Las Vegas, Thursday thru Saturday, June 16-18, 2022.




Visitors can "Double Down" on the experience elbow-toelbow with knowledgeable collectors, dealers, history buffs

and celebrities and join in the fun of examining, buying, selling, trading or valuing gaming and casino collectibles and mementos. Many rare, unique and one-of-a-kind casino paraphernalia will be on display and offered for sale. The show is open to everybody, with a \$10 admission on Thursday, \$5 on Friday, and FREE on Saturday.

2,222 is also the number of items in the Guinness World Record for world's largest private collection of casino chips and tokens. It will be on display as show attendees walk into the exhibit hall. CCA member Gregg Fisher's collection received this honor this January.

Show attendees will find displays nearly everything casino related, including gaming table chips, slot machine tokens, dice, slot cards, playing cards, matchbooks, menus, dinnerware, swizzle sticks, post





cards and more. "Collectors like many of our dealers have researched and journeyed to the big city casinos as well as the back roads tiny casinos, and written books documenting the rich history of gaming. If you

find casinos – and specifically casino
history – a fascinating topic, mark your
calendar now to attend this show," said
Jerry Vergatos, President of the Casino
