We also have a HUGE donation that includes well over 1,500 chips and tokens ,and comes from an awesome donor who prefers to remain anonymous.










2020 Raffle donations, so far! Clockwise from upper-left corner: Albert Powell, David Spragg, Anonymous, Friend of the Club.


Convention Program Editors

Monthly Newsletter Cartoon Strip

Just after Christmas 2003 my best friend Curt and I were hanging out in his man cave talking about how certain things (i.e. South Park) started out simple (in their case a cheesy animated Christmas card) and suddenly exploded into something huge. Over that New Year's holiday we created a comic strip about a pen (with arms, legs and eyes) that walks around a desktop and gets so scared when he accidentally sets off a computer screen saver that he leaks ink (wets himself). Over the next 6-7 years we created more than 25 characters and 500+ comic strips that we shared on MySpace, Facebook and even The Chip Board. We made some crude videos and got ourselves a website: www.officesurprise.com.

While our strip never exploded, and over time, our lives got more complicated (college, children, divorce, re-married, careers, houses, etc.) we stopped creating strips regularly. In July of 2019 we discussed restarting our comic and put our website back into "under construction" but have not done anything else. In October Jim [Follis] asked me if I was willing to write a comic once a month for the CCA Newsletter, focusing on casino collectibles using the Office Surprise characters.
