

The Museum of Gaming History is disappointed to announce that our Chairman, Mike Quinlivan, has officially relinquished his title as Chairman of the Board of Directors, and as a Board member.

All of us with the MoGH would like to personally thank Mike for his years of hard work and dedication to the MoGH. Mike has done many great things in helping us to grow and plan for the future.

COVID-19 woes...

Like so much of the rest of the country the MoGH has been impacted by the virus. We have several projects that have been temporarily put on hold by the lock down.

One of the MoGH's most immediate concerns was to find a replacement for our former Chairman, Mike Quinlivan. The remaining Board members went through the process to recommend a candidate to the CCA Board. That candidate was Approved by the CCA Board, and I am pleased to be that individual. The MoGH Board will now go through the process to appoint a Vice-Chairman, to replace me.

Our work to create a Legendary Stardust Tribute Project remains on-hold. Hopefully, Jim Follis's great work on this project will continue soon, as June 4th will be the first day of casino re-openings in Las Vegas.

Before the virus struck we had nearly reached completion on a deal with Terrible's Casino in Jean, NV to do a presentation of 3, MoGH Milestone display cases. Jerry Vergatos has done a great job on negotiating these displays. Again, our work for Terrible's will probably be delayed until August.

One of our near term Projects and goals is to fill-in several Board of Director vacancies and possibly even expanding the Board by several

The MoGH is presently working to create larger and steadier revenue flows and is thus working to creating a Fund Raising Committee and Action Plan. This was identified as one of our greatest needs to long term growth and is therefore our biggest short term concern and objective.

The MoGH has been discussing an actual museum location with the Circus Circus Hotel and Casino. They have a space that might be perfect for the MoGH. Although the virus and sale of the Circus Circus have created some short term stumbling blocks, the possibility still exists that the Museum of Gaming History could finally become a real, brick and mortar reality.

An important part of making our goal, to build a real museum a reality, is planning and having a Business Plan. The Board of Directors held a 2-day event in February with long time consultant Sandra Harris.

Out of this event Ms Harris put together a combined short term and long term Business Plan for the MoGH. This included not only the necessary planning elements, but a profit and loss guide with a detailed expense plan outlined for opening a 18,000 square foot museum. The revenues, costs and expenses can be readily adjusted for differing square footages and locations. The MoGH is continuing to move forward. All of us with the Board of Directors of the Museum of Gaming History would like to take this time to wish all of our members and their families, good health and well being during these difficult times.

It is a great tutorial on how to tag the images in ChipGuide as representations of your own collection, along with tagging images to show others what items you want to add to your collection, which items you have extras/traders, and how ChipGuide can assist in making trades by comparing want lists to trade lists.

And lastly, it introduces a new ChipGuide feature the "Top 10's to 100!" This project is an effort to see what are the top, most favored chips, tokens, plaques, dice, matchbooks, ashtrays, jetons. Silver Strikes, and more.
