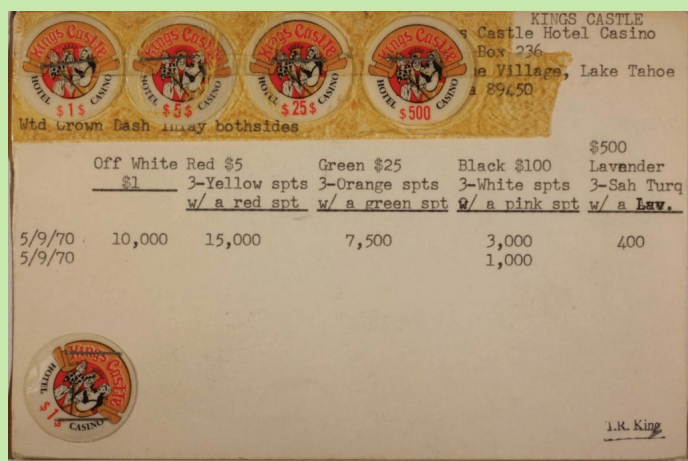

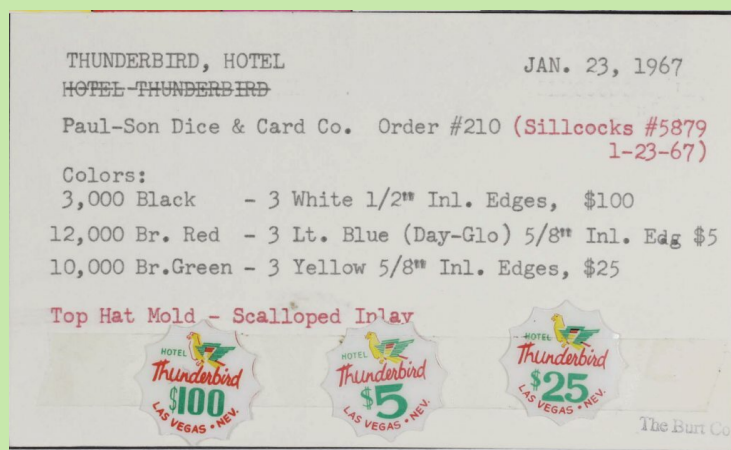

**Clerical Assistance is Needed** - At the 2022 Convention we asked attendees to complete Registration Cards that asked series of questions that were to be used following the Convention to ascertain certain statistical data. Brad Smith was provided with the completed cards and he has now finished his part of the process. We now need to transcribe and collate the remaining information into a spreadsheet (Excel or Access) for further processing. Accordingly, we are in need of an individual with data entry experience, along with the basic computer equipment and skills. Additional details will be posted at the Club's website, along with the desired qualifications and a description of work to be performed. Ideally, a candidate should be a member of the CCA, as the data is considered to be proprietary unto the CCA, however, we will certainly be happy to discuss allowing a Club member business owner, with clerical employee(s) to help.

**Rental of CCA Property** - The CCA Board was contacted by the President of the SNCCC requesting the loan of a supply of table-top (All-State) aluminum and glass display cases, for their upcoming Fall Show, stating that he had seen such loans in the past. He was advised that over 10 years ago, the then serving Board, had set a precedent that such display cases are available for this purpose, however, a rental fee of \$10 per case was set at that time. The SNCCC President accepted this past policy and will be renting a to-be-determined number of the Club's All-State display cases for the Show.

The continuance of this policy is consistent with the provisions of the Club's Constitution (Article 3, Paragraph (C):

*Under no circumstances, except under a Court-ordered dissolution, shall any money, funds, possessions, commodities, or anything else of value, be given, donated, transferred, sold (except for fair market value) to any organization, person or entity, charitable or otherwise, other than an organization or entity owned and/or operated by The Casino Chip & Gaming Token Collectors Club, Inc.*

Meanwhile, Charles also

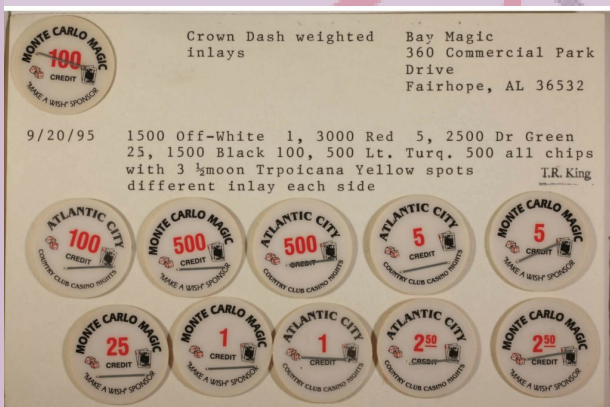

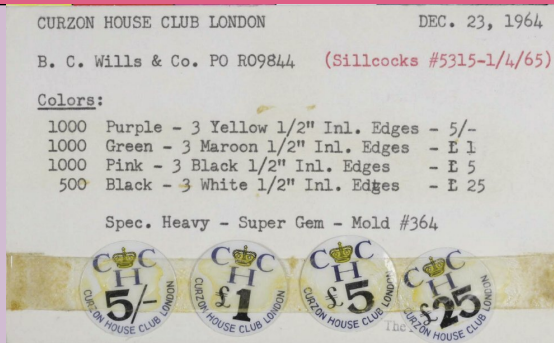

in a follow up to presenting his extensive Nevada Casino Cigarette Lighter collection, also on [thechipboard.com](http://thechipboard.com).

With each posted ashtray image, by special arrangement with Charles Kaplan, they were then submitted to Charles Kaplan, who would then edit, format and upload each image to ChipGuide.

This work was done for 1,061 ashtray images!

From there, Charles created a Special Collection for the ashtrays. However, in a display difference from the Order Card collection, when visiting the Siri Special Collection, one also sees other

ashtray submissions for the same casino.

Basically, when the Siri Special Collection is clicked, a list appears, alphabetically by casino names. When one clicks



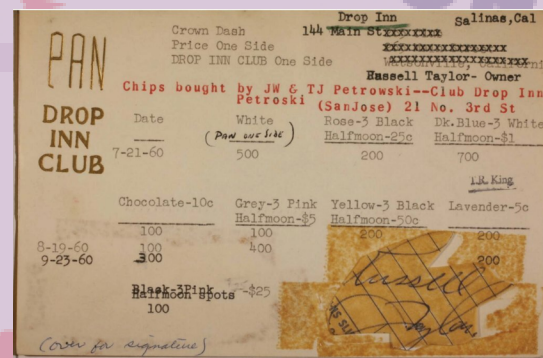
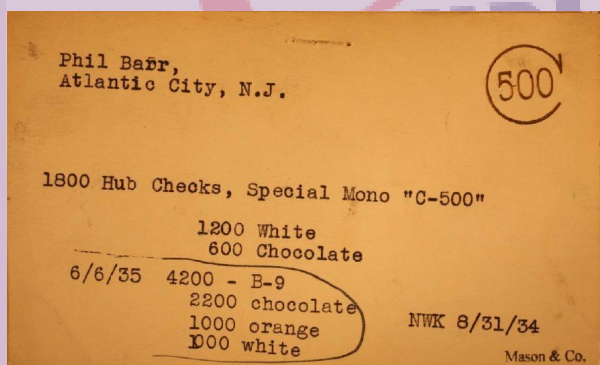
any given casino name, the display will show all the ChipGuide images of

ashtrays for that casino. This is done so that it allows a greater perspective of all ashtrays known for each casino can be seen, not just the ones contributed by the Siri's. It should be noted that some images, provided by Richard Siri, are not used, as a prior submission(s) will continue to be used. This is consistent with a fairness policy long in

effect for duplicate entries (Submissions) to ChipGuide.

In other MoGH developments, the MoGH's Chairman received a request from the

President of the SNCCC, asking to borrow a tall display case, to display the "Trail of the MoGH's" Guinness World's Record, Largest \$1 Casino Chips and Tokens Collection, currently on Exhibit at Spinettis



Gaming Supplies in Las Vegas, at the SNCCC Fall Chip Show. Both the temporary relocation of the Exhibit and use of the display case for a reasonable rental fee, was coordinated.

Separately, arrangements have been made to extend the Agreement to display the Guinness World's Record at Spinettis for an additional 12 months. Details will be provided in the October issue of the CCA Newsletter.
