**PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL CHANGE** - Life Member Brenda Reimer has submitted a proposed Constitional change, as shown below, to President Spragg, and will be presented, officially, to the membership via the CCA's <u>Casino Collectible News</u>.

# Proposed Constitutional Change Brenda Riemer (Life member)

As the election cycle approaches for our club, I have been thinking about ways in which interested members could gain experience so that they would be viable candidates for the positions of president, vice president, treasurer, secretary, and the membership officer. We currently have wonderful people volunteering their time, but all of us know that at some point in time, people get tired and wish to step back from officer duties. With this in mind, I am proposing a change to the constitution which would add two, Members at Large to the Board.

The two new positions are non-voting positions, but the individuals in the positions would gain a lot of experience about how our Board operates. Please note that all of us will have the opportunity to vote on the Constitutional change. The Board of Directors is the body that will modify the By-Laws. The suggested changes are on the next page, in red.

The Board of Directors of the CCA have approved of the presenting of this Constitutional change for voting by the Membership.

### **ARTICLE FOUR - OFFICERS, DIRECTORS & ELECTIONS**

### Section 1

The Club shall be governed by a President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, a Membership Officer, and two non-voting Members at Large.

### Section 2

A Board of Directors will be comprised of the five (5) seven (7) Club officers.

### Section 3

### A)

- (i) The President, and Secretary and one Member at Large position will be elected for a two year term in each year ending in an odd number,
- (ii) The Vice President, Treasurer, and Membership Officer and one Member at Large position will be elected for a two year term in each year ending in an even number; except that:
  - (a) In the election to be held in 2009, the Vice President, Treasurer and Membership Officer will be elected for a one year term, and thereafter as provided above.
  - (b) In the first election for Member at Large positions, one (1) individual will be elected for a one year term and one (1) individual will be elected for a two year term.

### **By-Laws:**

- F. Member at Large (2)
  - 1. Represent membership on the Board
  - 2. Chair initiatives as requested by the President
  - 3. Assist one of the committee chairs, such as the Membership chair and the Convention chair.
